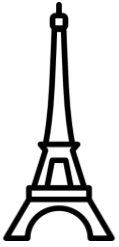

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Once nominations are processed, ESME sends applicants and their International Mobility Coordinators an application form. Applicants have to fill it out carefully.
- Once filled out, applicants have to print out the application form, sign it and have an institutional representative at the Home Institution sign it as well.
- All application documents must be emailed to international@esme.fr on or before **June 19, 2026**.
- Applications are processed on a first come, first served basis. **Applicants are encouraged to apply as early as possible.**
- Applicants and their International Mobility Coordinators can expect to hear back from ESME approximately 2 weeks after submitting their applications.

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- Electronic application form** filled out
- Scanned application form** filled out and **signed by applicant and Home Institution PDF**
- Official transcripts** in English **PDF**
- Photo JPG**
- Scanned copy of a valid passport / ID for EU citizens** (signature + picture pages) – valid at least 6 months after the end of the Fall semester at ESME **PDF**
- Proof of English proficiency** – no official test results required, letter/certificate for Home Institution accepted **PDF**

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	<p>In order to follow lectures taught in English and perform the required tasks, students must have a good level of English*.</p> <p><i>Level B1 – IELTS 5 – TOEFL IBT 42 – TOEIC 550 is recommended.</i></p> <p>*No official test results required, letter/certificate for Home Institution accepted</p>
COURSES	<p><u>Registration to classes:</u> Once the applicant’s Learning Agreement is validated both by applicant’s Home Institution and ESME, he/she will be automatically enrolled in the selected courses.</p>



The International Office at ESME recruits student buddies for international students in order to facilitate academic and social integration into the school life.



ESME does not provide on-campus housing, but its Housing Office and International Office can provide students with guidance and recommendations for room/apartment/host family in the Paris area. ESME partners with a Housing provider that helps international students in their search for accommodation.



- **ACCOMMODATION** ≈ 500 to 1000€ /month (room, studio)
- **PARIS PUBLIC TRANSPORT PASS** ≈ 75€/month
- **FOOD** ≈ 150€/month
- **PARTIES – GOING OUT** ≈ 60€/month
- **CULTURAL VISITS** ≈ 15€/month
- **MOBILE PHONE PLAN** ≈ 10€/month



Applicants must check the immigration process (type of required ID, visa if needed, etc.) with the consular authorities and/or with the local Campus France Agency in their home countries.
