INU NOTIFICATIONS

**INU opens applications
twice a year**

Spring Semester

Application Period:
September → October

Fall Semester

Application Period:
April → may

Who Can Apply?

- Undergraduate: All foreign students (Freshmen & Transfer)



Eligibility and Qualifications

FRESHMEN

Nationality

Applicants whose parents and themselves are all foreign nationals (pure foreigners)

Academic

Must have completed elementary, middle, and high school in Korea or abroad.
Must be a high-school graduate or expected graduate.
Not accepted: Korean GED, overseas GED, homeschooling, cyber-learning.

Language Proficiency

Korean Track:
TOPIK Level 3+ (some majors require 4+) OR INU Korean Language Center Level 4+ (some require Level 5+) OR INU Korean Proficiency Test (IT: 70+, Others: 60+)
English Track (IBE only):
TOEFL iBT 75 / TOEIC 700 / IELTS 5.5 / PETS 4
Native English-speaking countries may be exempt.

NOTES ▼

Korean Track students must reach TOPIK 4+ before graduation.
English Track: Some courses may be taught in Korean.
All students must complete the IPA Mandatory Korean Language Liberal Arts Program after admission.



Eligibility and Qualifications

TRANSFER

Nationality

Applicants whose parents and themselves are all foreign nationals (pure foreigners)

Academic

Transfer to 2nd Year:
Completed 1 year (2 semesters) of a 4-year university, OR
Graduated from a 2-3 year college.
Transfer to 3rd Year:
Completed 2 years (4 semesters) of a 4-year university, OR
Graduated from a 2-3 year college.

Language Proficiency

Korean Track:
TOPIK Level 3+ (some majors require 4+)
English Track (IBE only):
TOEFL iBT 75 / TOEIC 700 / IELTS 5.5 / PETS 4
Native English-speaking countries may be exempt.

Preparation of Academic Documents

01 Consular Authentication

Authentication by a Korean consulate in the country where the applicant's school is located, or by the consulate of the applicant's country in Korea.

02 APOSTILLE

After notarizing the translation (in Korean or English) of the original documents

03 (Applicants who have obtained academic degrees in China)
Academic Credential Verification Report (issued by the Academic Credential Verification Center operated by the Ministry of Education of China)



Application Procedure



Access the Incheon National University admission website: <http://admission.inu.ac.kr> and Select 'Online Application for International Student'



Register by entering personal information, including your full name and passport number as stated in your passport



Complete the online application form, submit it online, and print out the application form



Submit all required documents (including the printed online application form) to the Office of International Affairs, Incheon National University, either by post or in person



Pay the application fee
